This Nationally recognised qualification reflects the role of Counsellors, who work with clients on personal and psychological issues using established counselling modalities. They use communication, micro-counselling and interview skills and draw on varied counselling therapies to assist client.

At this level, the counsellor will be working in defined and supported counselling roles in established agencies rather than in independent practice.

Gallang Education & Training requires that potential students for this qualification are currently employed (or volunteering) in the community services and health industry supporting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander and other communities. This ensures assessment requirements that skills be demonstrated in the workplace or in a simulated environment are met.

On completion of this qualification students can undertake further education and training or seek employment within the community services industry in supported Counselling, Case Worker or Support Worker roles.

<b>Course Duration</b>	<p>Eighteen (18) months (It may be shorter if you are eligible for Credit Transfer/s or Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). Please speak with the GET Team.</p> <p>An extension can be granted due to serious circumstances, approval will need to be requested.</p>
